



Key Duties of a 4th Degree District Marshal



A 4th Degree District Marshal is equivalent to a District Deputy

Supervision: General supervision over Assemblies and Exemplifications within their assigned district. (Assigned by District Master)

Color Corps Training: Organize and conduct training for new and existing Sir Knights on the "Manual of the Sword," drill, and proper, respectful wear of the uniform.

Administrative Oversight: Review and examine assembly records, ensuring adherence to the Laws and Rules Governing the Fourth Degree.

Ceremonial Duties: Assist the Master in conducting the Exemplification of the Fourth Degree and managing ceremonial protocol during church or civic events.

Promotion of Patriotism: Foster the Fourth Degree's mission to promote active Catholic citizenship and patriotic spirit.

Attend all or as many as possible of their assigned area Assembly meetings.
