CP Report:

I encourage all officers (and members) to make good use of our monthly newsletter. Priorities and Reminders

Retention and Reactivation will be a major focus this year—more so than establishing new councils.

State is emphasizing that ALL Council Financial Secretaries must submit their required forms (185, 365, etc.) online. Handwritten or mailed-in forms will not be accepted. Financial Secretaries must become familiar with and use the online membership management tools.

Safe Environment Compliance

The Safe Environment program remains a top priority. Once forms 185 and 365 are submitted, four key officers—Grand Knight, Program Director, Family Director, and Community Director—will receive email instructions and must complete their training within 30 days.

All members assigned to Safe Environment roles should log into Praesidium Academy via the green button below using their Academy email and password.

IMPORTANT: There are two (2) required training modules for compliance. Additionally, a background check authorization must be completed by those assigned.

Please note: The self-registration portals (“Blue Button” and “Orange Button”) are currently unavailable. Thank you for your patience.

If you haven't already, please ensure your GK, DGK, Family Director, and Community Director complete the mandatory Safe Environment training as soon as possible. It only takes 30 minutes every three years, and it's important for both personal and legal liability protection.
