Purpose:

In compliance with Supremes' directive, all California Chapters are required to publish and promote their upcoming CUF (Charity, Unity, Fraternity) schedules for each Council within their jurisdiction. This ensures that any new member seeking exemplification can conveniently locate and attend a CUF Ceremony in the shortest amount of time possible.

Background:

Supreme has mandated that every Council open its CUF ceremonies to all councils, facilitating broader access and membership engagement.

Action Taken:

The SJC-6 Chapter successfully worked with the State Council to develop and link a unified, [Chapter-wide CUF Schedule](#). This schedule is now integrated into the [KofC CA State CUF Calendar](#), fully meeting all required data points:

Website Integration:

The [CUF Schedule](#) has been published on the [SJC-6 Chapter Homepage](#) and we have now added an this information directly on each Council's homepage, ensuring quick and universal accessibility.

Data Access and Updates:

Previously, only the Chapter Webmaster and District Deputies (DDs) could update the CUF Schedule. This practice has not been updated to include ALL BROTHERS allowing full access to add their own upcoming CUFs directly without restrictions.

Result:

Members can easily find and update CUF events by visiting their own Council's homepage and clicking the [CUF link](#) under the **"Upcoming Events"** section. This collaborative effort enhances participation, reduces administration time, and fulfills Supremes' mandate efficiently. Our Header on the CUF page is locked down and provides all the info needed.
